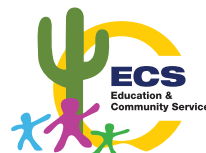
Mon June 11	DRAW	Work from reality and design a drawing using still life	Drawing techniques using charcoal and pen and ink	Leave with a complete original drawing

■ What the Hue - Color Exploration With Paint

Create Paintings that **POP!** Explore the dynamics of color using acrylics and canvas paper. In this class, students will experience the power of color through mastering color mixing, creating a variety of mood and emotional qualities, experimenting with effects gained by color choice and shading techniques enhanced by transitioning from one color to the next. No prerequisite class is needed for this class.

■ The Art & Craft of Digital Photography

This is a class designed for those photographers who want a deeper understanding of their DSLR and how they can better utilize its capabilities to create better photographs. Subjects include: The "Craft" - Using manual camera settings such as the f-stop and shutter speed, lens choice, how to use white balance, and learning about depth of field and special exposures. The "Art" - Mastering composition concepts such as pre-visualization (seeing what the camera sees), the rule of thirds, balance and simplicity, the art of subtraction and the near-far concept (use of the best foreground and background). Anyone can make a great photograph! One day of class students will go on a location shoot. Students are required to provide their own DSLR camera.

■ Beyond the Hue - Special Effects with Paint & Mixed Media Techniques

Create dazzling paintings using special effects and mixed media. In this class students will learn how to preserve the white of the paper, control the paint with traditional techniques, and create fantastic textures using salt, wax resist, rubbing alcohol, plastic wrap, and other mixed media. No prerequisite class is needed for this class.
